

-MS in Biomedical Sciences

What is it?

This research-intensive program allows eligible students to earn a Bachelor's of Science (BS) Degree in Biomedical Sciences, immediately followed by a Master's of Science (MS) Degree in the same discipline. Normally this sequence would take a minimum of 6 years, however this program allows students to complete both degrees in 5 years of continuous study.

How does it help me reach my career goals?

This program is beneficial to any student interested in gaining graduate-level research experience in biomedical sciences. Research topics that can be pursued are diverse and can prepare graduates wanting to enter many different fields.

Am I eligible?

To apply to this program, you must meet the following criteria:

f Junior status (60-90 credits earned)

f Completion of at least 15 credits in the Biomedical Sciences plan of study at UNF

How does it work?

Students complete the undergraduate degree first, taking 12 credits of graduate level coursework as part of the 120 total credits required to earn a BS. Those 12 credits double count for both the BS and MS. Once the BS is completed, students move on to the MS degree, earning an additional 24 credits of graduate level coursework in the following year.
