F-2 DEPENDENT COMPLIANCE FORM

Your role and responsibilities for compliance with F-2 Laws and Regulations

Below is a copy of the F-2 Dependent Compliance form. All new F-1 students with F-2 dependents are required to read and acknowledge understanding and compliance of the items in this form as part of International Student Check-In.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children must be under the age of 21
Immigration Documents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Keep a valid, unexpired passport and I-20
Employment/ Study	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> May not accept employment or engage in business under any circumstances. F-2 spouses may not engage in a full course of study. F-2 spouses and children are permitted to enroll in "less than a full course of study" at a SEVP-certified post-secondary or vocational institution, even if the course of study done part-time leads to or counts towards a degree. An F-2 child may engage in full-time study, including any full course of study, in any elementary or secondary school (kindergarten through twelfth grade).
Travel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have a valid travel signature on the I-20 before leaving and re-entering the U.S.
Duration of Status	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dependents in F-2 status for 0 to 5 years. As dependents of international students, we strongly encourage you to read and understand your responsibilities in your dependent's status in the Code of Federal Regulations 8 C.F.R. §14.2(f). If you have any questions about a dependent's status, please come to the office and talk to your international student advisor.
